The Electrical Contractors Licensing Board (ECLB) Continuing Education requirements for Electrical Contractors for the renewal period September 1, 2016 - August 31, 2018, are as follows: Fourteen hours of ECLB approved continuing education. Seven hours must be on technical subjects; one hour on workers' compensation; one hour on workplace safety; one hour on business practices; one-hour laws and rules; and a one hour approved advanced building structural course. Contractors who are engaged in alarm system contracting must also take a two-hour False Alarm Prevention course. If you do not need False Alarms credit, the hours will convert to "General" credits.
